- A high school student who was killed while crossing Park Street on Feb 5th.
- The work we're doing isn't just important- it could save lives.

Marquette Elementary "School Streets"

- City is hoping to prohibit vehicle traffic on Jenifer between Thornton and Rogers for an hour each morning and afternoon, to improve safety on school pedestrian routes
- Joined by Colleen Hayes, City of Madison Pedestrian and Bicycle Outreach Specialist

SJC Updates

- SJC appealed the city decision to remove benches and storage boxes. Timeline?

Budget

- Approved for \$1,000. This will cover Park(ing) Day and the permitting process for the traffic calming project, which means implementation couldn't happen until the 2027 budget cycle.

Riverside @ Winnebago Traffic Conflicts

- Issue with cars waiting side-by-side to exit Riverside, potentially blocking incoming traffic. Asked about possible paint or removal of Riverside parking spaces closest to intersection

Madison Lakeway PIM

- No significant updates which will impact Marquette- budget concerns caused the Skyline Pier to shrink from 4,000 sqft to 500 sqft. Transportation aspects remained unchanged (10' inside lanes, 11' outside lanes, bike path separate from walking/jogging path)
