Riverside @ Winnebago Traffic Conflicts

- Riverside Church agrees about traffic flow issues. Contacted traffic engineering (included follow up on Thornton/Jenifer signage), awaiting response

Williamson @ Thornton, Livingston Crossings

- Response from WI Council of the Blind, schools/principals, or PTGs?
- Thornton: PTG/principal agree crossing is hazardous, want bumpouts. MadCat and Stillgoods feel similarly, want on-street parking, clearer signage for cars
 - Sign warning heading Westbound, not comparable Eastbound sign. No 'lower' sign on the opposite street side. "Lane ends, merge here" heading Westbound.
